

## Camp Information

**CAMP COST:** \$100.00 is the cost for each camper. The cost includes insurance coverage, a canteen / fruit card, and a t-shirt celebrating our week of camp. To ensure your t-shirt you must pre-register by June 1.

**AGES OF CAMPERs:** 8-18 years of age. Campers must be a minimum of 8 years of age by the date camp begins, or as old as a newly graduated senior from high school. Campers between the ages of 2-7 years old will cost \$50.00 and must be at camp with a parent.

**DATES OF CAMP:** **CCYC** officially begins June 18-23, 2023 with Sunday evening services at 7:00 p.m. (EDST). Campers may begin to arrive at the campground mid-afternoon on Sunday. Please not before. Camp will end Friday at 11:15 a.m. (EDST).



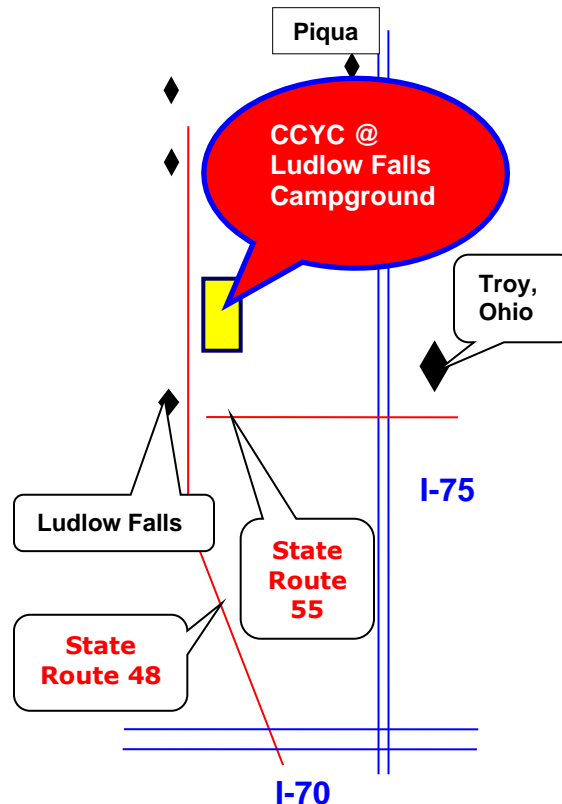

## What Should I NOT Bring?

### **PLEASE NOTICE THESE RULES**

Each congregation is responsible to have every camper that comes with your group or your congregation ready to attend CCYC in accordance to these requirements. **NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES, (this includes cell phones)** for reasons of safety and distraction please leave them at home. Please do not plan on wearing tank tops, sundresses, skimpy, torn, or tight fitting clothing. No clothing with inappropriate logos and quotes. Boys and girls may wear shorts as long as they are at the top of the knees.

**Christian modesty is EXPECTED AND REQUIRED in dress and conduct for all campers...both boys and girls.**

## Arrivals and Departures

Camp begins with Sunday evening services, at 7:00pm. Camp ends Friday 11:15 p.m. **Please pick up the campers no later than (noon) 12:00pm on Friday afternoon of camp.** There will be no supervision for them after the close of camp.

## Rules to Remember

1. Everyone is required to keep the camp schedule.
2. No one will be permitted to leave camp unless granted by the camp manager.
3. Sickness or injury must be reported to the camp medic and no one will be excused from class except at the request of the medic.
4. In matters of dress, modesty must prevail.
5. Boys will not be allowed to wear piercings of any kind.
6. Girls are to wear no piercings except earrings.
7. All visitors must honor camp rules.
8. All overnight visitors are required to rent cabins or hotel dorms.
9. We reserve the right to dismiss any child immediately due to medical or disciplinary reasons.

The camp management reserves the right to dismiss and exclude from camp anyone who does not obey the camp rules and regulations. This will be done at the expense and the responsibility of the parents and/or guardians of the insubordinate child. We come for a Christian purpose and there will be no favoritism displayed to any person or group of persons while at CCYC.
