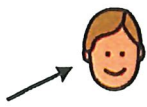
Wednesday- **Isaiah 53:1-2**

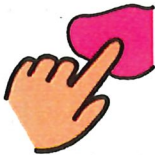
Thursday- **Matthew 28:19-20**
